	0	5. 1. Describe the student's overall competence of designing, as apparent from the demo / exhibition and showcase
		During the B11 project the team experienced a complete design process, resulting in a convincing prototype that demonstrated their concept well. The process was focussed around 'exploring' and 'making', which is normal during B11. Together with Tijmen, Pleun took the lead in the teamwork.
		I liked his showcase very much. It was good looking for a first showcase, easy to navigate and a good balance between text and illustrations.
	0	6. 2. Describe the student's vision on designing and identity, as apparent from the demo / exhibition and the showcase:
		Pleun made a good start with his vision. The aspect of societal change seemed to be missing, but this is of course his first vision ever. During the assessor-student meeting Pleun explained that he likes to contribute to the usability of products for specific users. This can come close to 'societal change'. I like the examples you showed in connection to your vision; you made a good selection, almost a mood board.
		His identity is a clear story as well. He sees himself as a problem solver and hands-on designer. This seems to be right when viewing all the movies of his DIY snow bike and hovercraft and his work on a solar powered vessel. Very nice to see! During the assessor-student meeting we discussed the relevance of these projects in relation to ID, but I think they tell a lot about who you are and how passionate you work on the things you like. And some of them have everything to do with design!

o 8. 2. Describe the student's growth for this semester.

Pleun appears to be motivated student, ambitious and hardworking. He has a realistic overview over his competency development. IT is not the most important competency to Pleun (however, this is a TU...), nonetheless it seemed to be fun when part of his project.

As with most B11 students, his reflections are too much focussed on what has be done. Even so I learn from his showcase that he is in charge of his own development and has a good understanding of the educational system of ID.

During an assignment he developed DBP, a competency that has little attention during his project. He received good feedback on his work and attitude and developed this competency well.

A draft PDP is missing, but in his showcase Pleun presents a clear picture of his next semester. He is clearly well aware of his own development.

 9. What advice would you like to give to the student with respect to future development?

Pleun, I like to give you the following advices:

- Your vision and identity are above average for a B11 student, from my point of view. Next step is to add the component of societal change (part of the mission of ID).
- You write clear reflections, however they are too much focussed on what you have done. Try to focus on what you learned and make links to your PDP goals.
- Two minor points: Add your assessor to your community (perhaps you did) and include a draft PDP in your next showcase.
